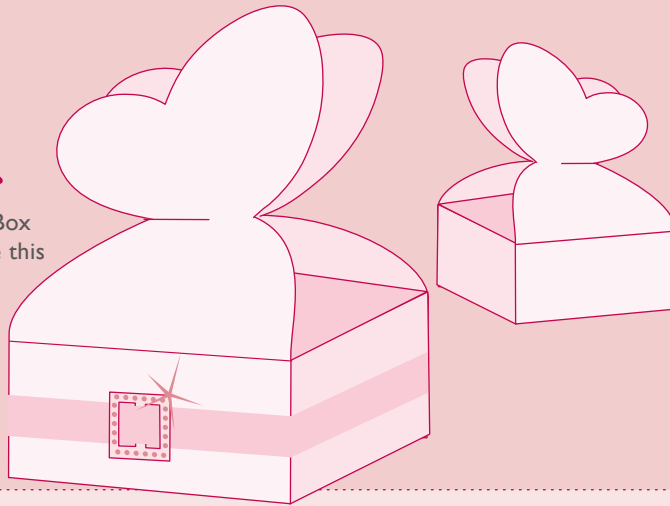

**WHAT YOU WILL NEED**

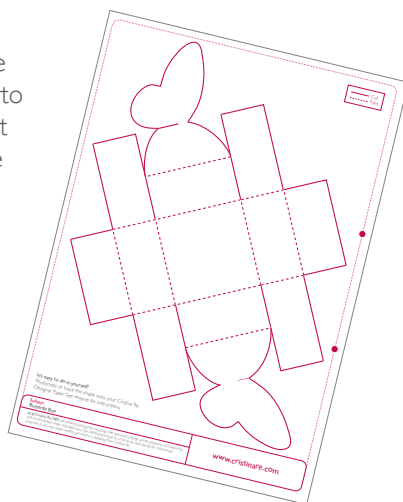
- Cristina Re A4 Designer Paper in the colour or design of your choice
- Suitable printer\* / photocopier
- Double-sided tape
- Scissors

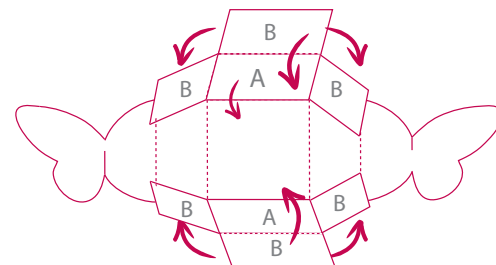
**STEP ONE**

Insert your favourite Cristina Re Paper into the printer and print the template on the reverse side of the Designer Paper.



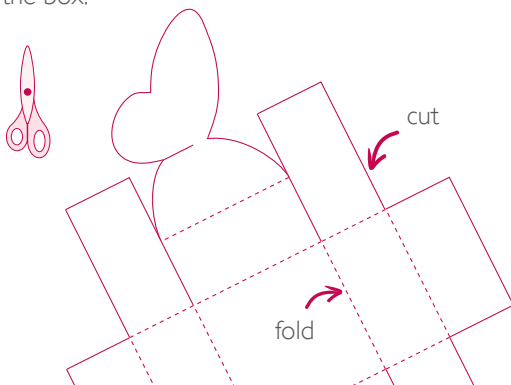
**STEP THREE**

Select flaps A and fold inward and then fold flaps B forward. To provide the box with support, secure the flaps, using double-sided tape.



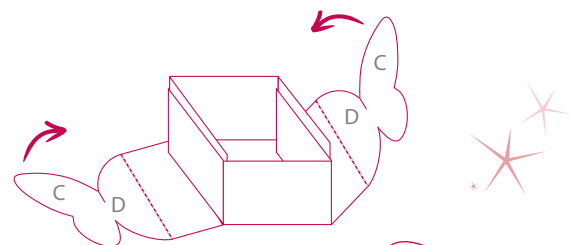
**STEP TWO**

Use scissors or a stanley knife to cut out the template, cutting solid lines only. Lines that are dotted indicate where you need to fold the box. Score and fold all dotted lines prior to constructing the box.



**STEP FOUR**

Fold flaps C in and secure box by interlocking the butterfly with the slits indicated at D.

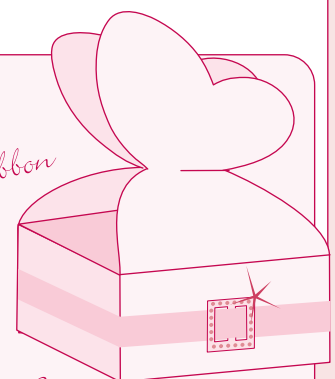


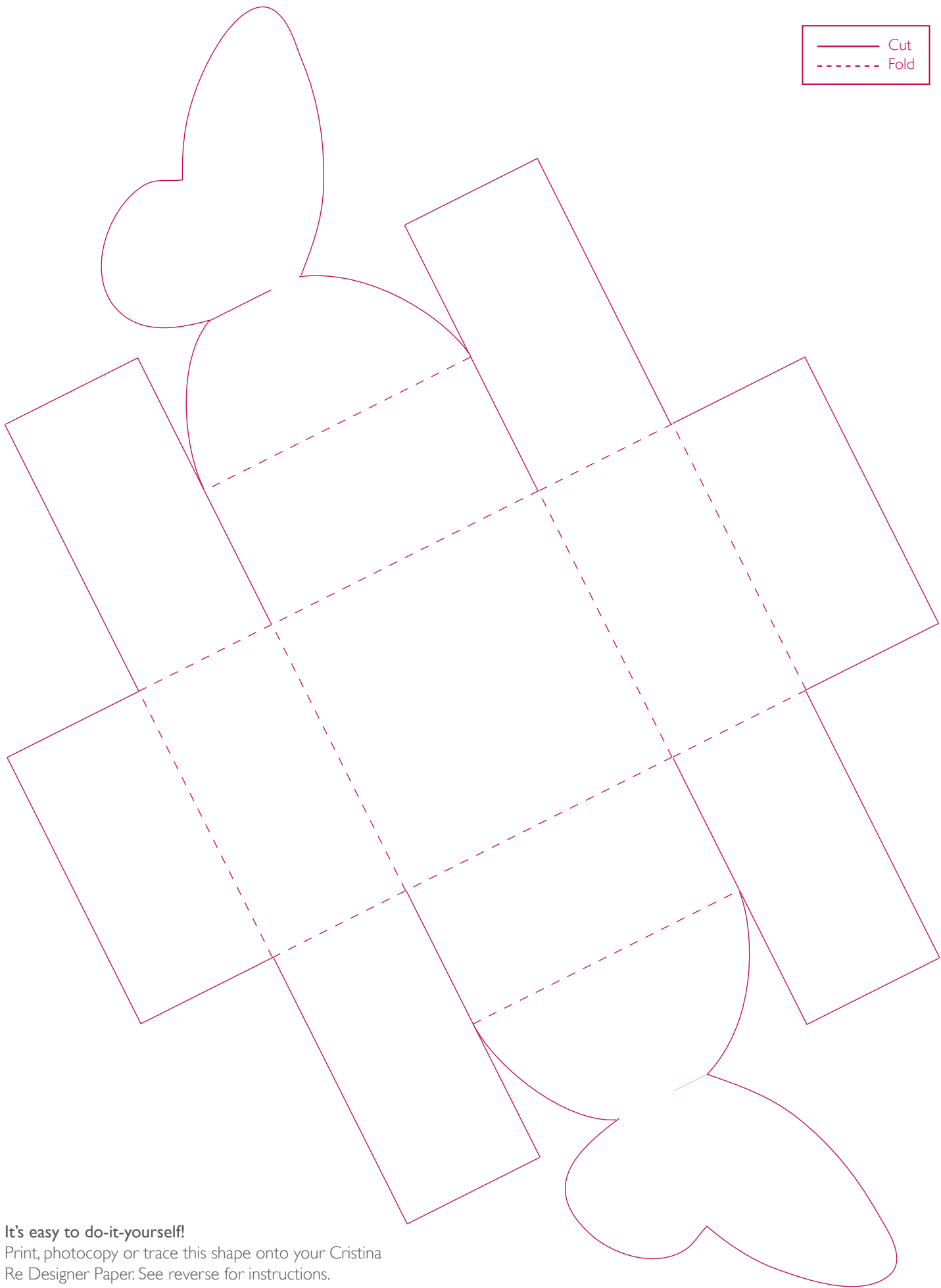
